



: Rally Time Trial : 15th March 2008 : Final Regulations

Dear Entrant,

We are pleased to inform you that your entry for the **envirocare** sponsored rally time trial 2008 has been accepted.

Entry list attached.

Your competition number for the event will be issued at documentation scrutiny. The onus is on dual entrants to ensure that the correct competition number is displayed appropriate to the timed run for that entrant.

Scrutiny:

All competitors are to report to the service area, entrance via roguery road. Scrutiny will begin at 8am; gates will be closed at 9am sharp. **All vehicles must be in the service area for this time.**

It is the entrants' responsibility to ensure their vehicle is entered in the correct class as classes will not be amended after documentation scrutiny.

Service area:

Only one service vehicle per crew is permitted in the service area. **No exceptions!**

Trailers are to be parked as directed by the marshal.

All crews must use ground sheets, failure to do so will result in automatic exclusion.

Please respect the grounds and place any rubbish in the bins provided. All mechanical and refuelling waste must be removed.

Refuelling:

Please read the service area risk management notices regarding refuelling procedures. Fire extinguishers will be in position in the service area please familiarise yourself with there location before any refuelling is carried out.

Driver briefing:

All drivers **must** attend briefing at 10.15am in the service paddock. **No exceptions**

Please note the speed restriction to stage start from service and from stage finish to service. Failure to comply will result in exclusion.

Stage familiarisation:

Stage familiarisation will be a **controlled convoy** at approx 10.30am followed immediately by 1st timed run at 11am sharp. Cars will start singly at approximately 30 second intervals. Beam timing will be in operation.

Red flag:

Drivers must stop immediately for waved red flag as per SR 22.

Results:

Provisional results will be posted in service area immediately after the event these results will become final 30minutes after the event. Awards presentation will then take place.

Please note:

The use of any form of motorised or pedal transportation in or around the circuit after 10am is strictly prohibited, this particularly applies to children.

If any person ignoring this instruction is connected to a competitor he/she will be excluded.
